## "Enchanté" Post-It Cover

Accessories: Enchanté Designer Series coordinating papers—

covers cut 6" x 4" (x2), binding strip 12" x 3" (x1),

Pencil 3 1/8 x1 1/4" (x1)

Chipboard:  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$  inches (x2)

Certainly Celery or Perfect Plum cardstock—inside cover

5 1/4 x 3 1/4 (x2); loops 1" x 3" (x2)

Grosgrain ribbon – Chocolate Chip, Spring Green or Eggplant-

10" each book (for cover)

Corrugator, Mini Pencils, Post It Notes (3x5) –1/3 pack for each



Gluing the book - Use "stick glue" to adhere the decorative paper to the chipboard and the pencil. It may seem tedious to have to "hold" it together (ex. face the book down and press for a few minutes to let the glue set on the binding and inside flaps.

For the pencil – it may be easier to crimp the 1x3" piece of decorative paper and flatten again before gluing to pencil (it will wrap easier)



- Applying the stick glue generously, cover the chipboard covers (fig. 1) and bind them with the long spine strip leaving a ½ inch in the center and fold the spine strip into the middle (inside) (fig. 2)
- Attach the loops (not too far apart, the pencil is only 3"), you may wish to corrugate the paper before you make a loop
- 3. Adhere the inside "mat" to cover the loops and chipboard (fig. 4)
- 4. Cover the pencil by first corrugating the 1x3" piece (to aid in bending), smoothing out and applying stick glue liberally. Hold the pencil shut tightly for at least 60 seconds.
