Sets: Snow Burst, Perfect Presentation (Level 2 Hostess Set)

Accessories: White Glossy cardstock, Blue Bayou cardstock and ink, Soft Sky cardstock and ink, Designer Series Paper Prints "Soft Sky", Versamark, crystal clear embossing powder, horizontal slot punch, 1/16th inch hole punch, round tab punch, 1 3/8 inch circle punch, Embossing Buddy, Crystal Brads "Ice Squares", Dimensionals™, tiny white lunch bags (3 1/2 x 7 inches cut to 3 1/2 x 3 inches), tiny pencils (www.vippies.com)

Purse Dimensions -White Glossy Cardstock cut 4 1/4 x 11, scored at 2 1/2, 6 1/2, 7, 7 1/2



1. Rub the Embossing Buddy all over the glossy cardstock (to ensure no embossing powder sticks).
2. Stamp the largest snowflake and the smaller snowflake in Versamark™ onto the glossy side and dust liberally with clear embossing powder and tap off.
3. Heat set the snowflakes, ensuring you heat until the powder melts to clear (too much heat will dull the finish, more will brown the paper, and well... smoke is never a good sign ☺)
4. Using the Sponge daubers, first sponge the Soft Sky on in a "cloudlike" manner (i.e., leaving light and dark areas. Repeat with the darker Blue Bayou sponge daubers. Take care to rub the dark blue into the detail of the embossed snowflakes to 'pop' out the whiteness!
5. Take a moment to fold the pocketbook at the score lines to define the panels
6. Punch out the tab from the Blue Bayou cardstock and adhere it what will be the front flap with mono and then punch a 1/16th inch hole and insert the crystal brad as shown. Thread the tiny pencil through the top.
7. Take the tiny white bag and fold down the back bottom flap and lay it down with the flat side up. Adhere the Designer Series paper with the dotted side out to the flat side then punch a half circle into the front and adhere the back to the middle panel.
8. On the glossy rectangle, stamp the snowman in Blue Bayou right in the center and adhere it to the bag front. Write 'Receipts' in the marker provided (bullet tip, not brush)
9. On the small glossy piece, stamp the "Don't Open Until Christmas" in Blue Bayou and punch out with the 1 3/8 inch hole punch
10. ****NOT SHOWN IN PHOTO**** Punch two holes on each side of the bottom (i.e., inside the score lines that are the bottom of the pocketbook when it is closed) and thread the ribbon through the bottom with the long ends hanging out to either side. Bring up one ribbon end behind and one in front and tie a bow and then a knot to secure the bow. Open the purse by slightly bending the pocketbook and slipping the bow over the corner edge.
