

Supplies: Kraft handle bag (8 ½ x 5 ¼ x 3 inches deep); 12 x 12 cardstock (for the folio), set of gift cards with matching envelopes (at least 6); tissue (party stores sell colored tissue, I used a “vanilla” tissue for this project)

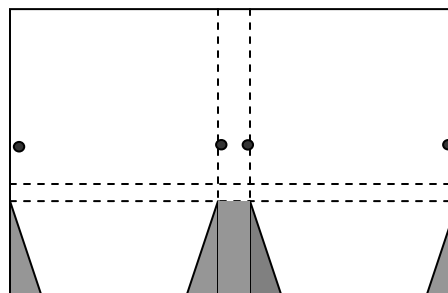
Directions:

- Pre-make your set of stationery based upon a card you like and can be easily personalized with a small greeting (Happy Birthday, Congratulations &

Thinking of You), which you will personalize with two of each saying.

- Cut, score & fold the 12x12 to 9 x 10 inches (see the folio via the template below) and decorate to coordinate with the stationery. Punch holes and thread the ribbon to close (no glue used).
- Cut an 8 ½ x 5 ¼ inch piece of cardstock for the false front of the gift bag and layer it to match the stationery.

10 x 9 inch rectangle base:
Score on 10" side at 4 ¾ & 5 ¼ inches
Score on 9" side at 6 inches & 6 ½ inches
